TERROIR

Clay-limestone made up of ancient gravelly alluvial deposits, remains of a huge alluvial cone from the streams descending Mont Sainte Victoire (1,010 metres) and bordered to the south by Mont Olympe and Mont Aurélien.

VINEYARD

Average age of vines: 30 years - Grape varieties: Grenache 60% Syrah 30% Cinsault 10% - Yield: 50 hl/ha. Sustainable farming. Vegan. Classified "High environnemental value"

VINIFICATION

18 days of cold tank stabilisation at 4° C in pre-fermentation phase, then temperature-controlled fermentation in stainless steel vats.

TASTING NOTES

Very pale color with rose gold reflections. Delicious and delicate nose of yellow peach and bergamot. An elegant palate, with a velvety freshness, of honeyed notes and pear.

MATCHING FOOD & WINE

Tuna and coriander tartar, ceviches, seafood risotto, lamb confit with garlic and thyme.
