

Domaine Coussin La Croix du Prieur rosé

Côtes de Provence

Named in the 18th Century by Jean-Baptiste COUSSIN, Château Coussin was purchased by Baptistin Gautier in 1903 and is today run by his descendants, Olivier and Sophie Sumeire who represent the 8th generation of Provençal winemakers.

Domaine Coussin - La Croix du Prieur is produced from the vines classified AOP Côtes de Provence of Château Coussin. The emblematic carved pediment of the façade adorns the labels of the wines produced on the estate.

VERT DE VIN : Note : 15+ / 89-90

TERROIR

A clay-limestone soil is protected from the maritime influence to the South by the Mont Aurélien and enjoys a climate with a mild continental influence. This region is considered to be one of the most natural in France thanks to the drying effects of the Mistral wind which protects the vines from disease.

VINEYARD

Vineyard of 30 ans

VINIFICATION

Low temperature stabilization for 18 days, followed by temperature controlled fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

TASTING NOTES

Beneath a bright, luminous colour with a delicate pale pink hue, the nose reveals wild strawberry aromas, characteristic of Coussin rosés, complemented by notes of fully ripe apricot. The palate is well balanced, with flavours of peach and nectarine alongside refreshing citrus notes.
