## Côtes de Provence

2021

Owned by a family of Provençal winegrowers since 1953, Château l'Afrique is today run by the descendants of Gabriel Sumeire, on the Côtes de Provence Pierrefeu terroir. The statue adorning the label, dated 1840 and placed at the end of the estate alley, is the work of sculptor Antoine Aprile, native from Cuers.

### TERROIR

Cuers-Pierrefeu : the red sandstone bedrock has produced a sandy limestone soil, which has combined with colluvial soil from the areas of high ground on either side of the terroir.

### VINEYARD

Grenache 40% Syrah 50% Rolle 10%

Average age of vines 30 years.

Yield 55 hl/ha.

Sustainable farming and High Environmental Value.

### VINIFICATION

Direct pressing of the destemmed grapes while filling the pneumatic press.

"Egouttage", light pressing at constant temperature.

### TASTING NOTES

An expressive and fresh nose of white peach, acacia and roses.

The palate is elegant and well balanced with notes of pear and a citrus fruit finish.

### MATCHING FOOD & WINE

Tuna poke, grilled prawns, vegetarian or chicken curry.
